 Update: Board of Library Commissions concerned. Our State building consultant came to building committee meeting and asked questions. Her concerns were helpful for the Selectmen to hear. Over \$3M grant. Waiting for over \$700K once completed and have certificate of occupancy. Board member said Town has been borrowing funds waiting for grant. Feeling like things are moving along now. Contract renewed to 2022 so we're not in danger of losing the additional grant money. General Contractor rehired by Insurance Company and they are holding them accountable.
