

## **Sherborn Library Reopening**

After prolonged construction delays, we are increasingly confident the fully renovated Sherborn Library will be opened to the public in early 2023.

### **Activities to Reopen**

On December 15th we received a Temporary Certificate of Occupancy from the Sherborn Building Commissioner and can start the process of moving furniture and books back into the building. During the moving process, the current library facilities will be unavailable to the public. Once the moving process is complete, the renovated Library will be reopened to the public. An official Ribbon Cutting ceremony will be held in the near future and a re-opening celebration event for the Sherborn residents later in 2023.
