1. Director's Report

Meeting postponed until Fall. Elections postponed also. Means new fiscal year starts before funding voted on. Concept around funding is to roll forward with 1/12th of previous year's budget every month. Also on Covid-19 task forces in Dover and Sherborn. Take it a day at a time. Trying to figure out re-opening timeframe and plan. Three phase plan. Trying to figure out the three phases to match social distancing recommendations. Need to balance the cleaning agents needed to sanitize with health of patrons. Still figuring out the details.

Great Sherborn Library Bake off went really well. 19 submissions. 1500 people engaged in the bake-off. Working on a seed sharing based on donation from Silverwood Farm and Hopesill Farm. Didn't promote as widely, but now will because have the seeds. Still have about \$1000 of the budget that wasn't used for programming. Discussed use for money. Maybe library in a box from local book store? Considering homesteading series. Suggested Katherine Head as gardening expert. Doing a ricotta making session too. eBook collection invested in further. eBook consumption year over year has almost doubled.
