Elizabeth Johnston: We've been working on the reopening ceremony, thank you for the great list of names for our mailing Brian. I learned that on Dec. 17 at 2 pm there is a memorial service for Evelyn Liffiton at Pilgrim Church. Evelyn was a cherished Sherborn person. Her husband Peter was a Library Trustee for many years and community volunteer. I recommend we move the ribbon cutting ceremony. Contacted MBLC, we could do December 18, 2022.
